
INSTANT INSANITY

The following is a poem which describes how to solve the problem of these instantly insane blocks. The blocks can be bought but, if you do not own your own set, they can be made up from the following plan in Figures 1-4: The idea is to make a four block unit with each of the four colours on each of the four long sides as in Figure 5.



The "Three-Redded" block has white to the top and blue's left to sit on the bottom. With green facing you and red out of view the first block is set in position.

Block Number Two; the "Double Blue"
has green to your left and your right.
Don't get fed up, have blue facing up
and then use what's called intuition.

Two whites and two greens, I think I'll be mean and tell only part of this clue; With blue out of view and white facing you you're left to make a decision.

Two reds and two whites, make the four blocks unite.
Put green on the top and then you can stop.
Four colours per side is part of this guide.
Thus ends my little description.
